How to Separate and Dispose of Household Garbage

(ごみの出し方)

Please Note

The fee for burnable and non-burnable garbage collections is charged through the mandatory purchase of Hachinohe City designated garbage bags. The bags and over-sized garbage tickets are available at most supermarkets and convenience stores.

- * Items that cannot fit into the 45-liter trash bag are considered over-sized garbage that requires an "oversized garbage ticket."
- * Garbage bags should be tied securely and place in the designated area on the day of collection. Garbage pick-up times vary depending on each residential area, and may range from 6:30a.m. to 8a.m.
- * Please adhere to the garbage disposal rules and keep the garbage disposal area clean.
- * There will be no garbage collection from December 31-January 3, on public holidays, or on compensatory holidays, with the exception that only burnable garbage will be collected if a national holiday or compensatory holiday falls on a Monday.

Make a reservation by TEL/FAX \rightarrow Purchase an "oversized garbage ticket" \rightarrow Attach the ticket on the garbage and place it outside your door.

Burnable Garbage

- * Drain water out of all kitchen scraps and remove all waste from disposable diapers.
- * When disposing of all cooking oils, be sure they are in solid form.
- * Shells and vinyl chloride bottles are considered burnable garbage.
- * There is a maxim limit of two bags per household per disposal.

Non-Burnable Garbage

- * Small electric appliances that can fit into the 45-liter designated garbage bag. Remove all batteries from battery-operated equipment and completely extract kerosene from stove heaters and polyethylene tanks.
- * Wrap all broken glass and cutleries with paper.
- * Extract remaining liquid from spray cans by puncturing a hole in the container.

Cans, Plastic and Glass Bottles (Put in the clear designated garbage bags)

- * Do not recycle containers that cannot be cleaned completely (detergents, cleaners, oil, etc.); dispose of them as burnable garbage.
- * Metal lids are non-burnable garbage; lids of other materials are burnable garbage.
- * Plastic bottles labeled "PET" are recyclable; other types of plastic are burnable garbage.
- * Rinse out "PET" bottles and remove the labels and caps before recycling.

Cardboard and Newspaper Disposal

- * Separate cardboards and newspapers and bind them with ropes; do not put in bags nor use gummed tapes.
- * Remove all adhesives, plastic wrappings and/or Styrofoam.
- * Select supermarkets collect Styrofoam trays and milk cartons for recycling.

Magazines and Fliers

- * Remove all adhesives and bind with ropes; do not put in bags nor use gummed tapes.
- * Items such as binders that contain metal parts that cannot be easily removed, dispose of them as burnable garbage.

Used Fabrics (Put in the clear designated garbage bags)

* Items to dispose of as burnable garbage instead of as used fabrics: materials that cannot absorb oil, such as wool and polyester; items smaller than 30cm x 30cm; items that contain cotton such as seat cushions and stuffed animals.

How to Dispose of Oversize Trash

- * Call for your reservation for oversized trash pickup. Check how many oversized trash tickets are necessary when you make your reservation.
- * Purchase oversized trash ticket(s). You can buy oversize trash tickets at stores that sell Hachinohe City Designated Garbage Bags. Please ask at the cash register because they are not usually displayed]
- * Write your name on the ticket and stick it on the trash you want to throw away.
- * Place the trash outside your door before 8:00 a.m. on the pickup day, and trash will be taken away.
